














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What is Neighborhood Watch

Time for a color change?

If you are considering having the exterior of your home painted, here are a few things to remember:

- 1. If you want to repaint the same color, but aren't sure WHAT color palette you have, pop over to Sherwin Williams. All of our homes are listed with them, and as long as you have your property information from the Hillsborough County Property Appraiser website i.e. "CORY LAKE ISLES PHASE 6 UNIT 1 LOT 20 BLOCK 2" then they should be able to look up your original paint color scheme. You do NOT have to submit a request for approval to the DRC if you are painting the same color.
- 2. If you want to change it up, please note that we have an approved color palette that must be used. There is a color book in the Beach Club that you can peruse, OR you can go to our POA website: www.corylakeislespoa. com and under Documents you will find the palette. You can then plug in the SW color code to the Sherwin Williams website to see the color for the body, trim and accent colors. You DO have to submit a request for approval to the DRC if you are changing from your current color scheme.

Rent Control Coming to Tampa Bay?

Local officials in Tampa are contemplating a form of rent control throughout the greater Tampa area, referred to by some officials as "rent stabilization".

What is rent control?

Rent control is a type of restriction that has been enforced in several cities over the years to essentially cap the amount homeowners can charge each month for their rentals.

Who is trying to make this happen and whv?

Rent control isn't simple. It requires a declaration of a state of emergency because, in Florida, currently there is no statute that limits the amount a landlord can charge for rent.

How has rent control worked in

There have been multiple studies in

regards to rent control programs that have been enforced in the past, in cities such as San Francisco. Below are just a few results of previous rent control studies:

- Extremely short-term help for current
- · Decreased affordability.
- · Led to mismatch with tenants vs home. For instance, empty nesters stay in large homes because the rent is more affordable, leaving fewer homes available for larger families. Or vice versa, growing families opt to stay in a rent-controlled property that has limited space available, due to a potential rent increase if they relocate.
- · Homeowners unable to afford the maintenance.
- · Renters don't turn to buyers in the usual

In greater Tampa Bay, rent prices increased by a record 24% in 2021. Over the past 24 months, Florida has experienced a significant increase of new residents seeking a more temperate climate, an open environment, and a more wallet-friendly cost of living. In May 2021, Florida State CFO, Jimmy Patronis, reported that about 900 people move to Florida daily. According to U-Haul, Florida came in second, narrowly beat out by Texas, as their two top growth states in 2021. New residents, as well as locals, all need a place to live, leading to a classic issue with supply and demand. Ideally, our local lawmakers will prioritize both landlords and renters. Many landlords are still paying mortgages, as well as taxes, insurance, and maintenance on their rental properties.

On February 24, 2022, Tampa's City Attorney, Gina Grimes', office will be presenting some possible solutions at a City Council workshop. It will be interesting to see the reports of what is being considered. I truly believe, some balance can be found with some innovative thinking and a straightforward conversation.
